

REGULATIONS of the Wrocław Independence Footrace Wrocław, 11 November 2019

I. OBJECTIVE

1. Commemoration of the 101st anniversary of regaining independence by Poland.
2. Popularisation and promotion of running as the simplest form of physical activity.
3. Promotion of the City of Wrocław.

II. ORGANISER

The organiser of the Wrocław Independence Footrace is Gmina Wrocław (Commune of Wrocław) – Młodzieżowe Centrum Sportu Wrocław (Youth Sport Centre Wrocław), PL 51-612 Wrocław, al. I. J. Paderewskiego 35, tel. +48 511 603 093, biegniepodleglosci@wroclawmaraton.pl

III. DATE AND PLACE

1. The Wrocław Independence Footrace will take place on **11 November 2019** on the streets of Wrocław, on one loop.
2. Start: Wrocław Market Square, 05:00 p.m. The competitors must check in at the start from 04:30 p.m. to 04:45 p.m.
Finishing line: Wrocław Market Square
3. Route length: 10 km. The route will have approvals of PZLA.
4. The competitors shall position themselves at the start according to the following order: the race elite - competitors having numbers from 1 to 100. About 10 m behind the elite, the other competitors shall position themselves in time zones compliant with the times declared in the entry.
The competitors shall start in waves.
5. The route shall be closed for longitudinal wheel traffic in compliance with the decision on the use of the Wrocław Independence Footrace route in a special way. The competitors shall be bound with the time limit amounting to 2 hours gross. The competitors who at the halfway point of the Wrocław Independence Footrace achieve the time exceeding 1.5 hour gross shall be obliged to stop running and to leave the race route. All competitors who fail to reach the finishing line by 07:00 p.m. shall be obliged to stop running and to leave the route or to ride to the finishing line by a microbus with the inscription: KONIEC BIEGU (END OF RACE).
6. 95% of the Wrocław Independence Footrace route has asphalt surface and 5% - cobble surface.
7. The route shall have all kilometres marked: from 1 to 10 (every 1 km).
8. The time checking points shall be located: at the start, 5 km and at the finishing line.
The nutrition point shall be located on about 5 km. At the nutrition point, there shall be tables with natural water.
9. The medical points shall be located at the nutrition point as well as the start/finishing line and they shall be operated by paramedics.
10. The toilet cabins shall be located behind the nutrition point and near the start/finishing line.
11. The organiser shall not provide a changing room.

IV. PARTICIPATION

1. Persons who will reach 18 years of age by 11 November 2019 shall be entitled to take part in the Wrocław Independence Footrace.
2. All competitors taking part in the Wrocław Independence Footrace must be verified in the Competition Office of the Wrocław Independence Footrace (Wrocław Market Square), which shall receive the competitors from 07/11/2019 to 10/11/2019 from 11:00 a.m. to 07:00 p.m. and on 11/11/2019 from 08:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. The starting packages shall be handed over solely during the verification. The packages not collected on those days shall remain at the disposal of the organiser. The competitors shall be obliged to:
 1. have an ID card or a passport for verification of the identity, date of birth and citizenship, subject to point V/12b,
 2. acknowledge receipt of the starting package during the verification (start number, a set of pins for fixing of the number to the T-shirt).
3. Decisions of the doctors relating to continuation of the race during the event shall be final and irrevocable.
4. Measurement of time and determination of order in the Wrocław Independence Footrace shall be made by means of an electronic system, on the basis of the chips stuck to the start numbers. Every competitor shall get a start number with a chip during the verification. The first 50 competitors shall be classified according to the place taken at the finishing line (gross time). The 51st competitor and the next competitors shall be classified

according to actually achieved time of completion of the Wrocław Independence Footrace (net time). Possession of the number during the entire race, moving solely on the race route and passing through all time checking points shall be the condition for taking part in the Wrocław Independence Footrace and being classified in the final announcement. During the Wrocław Independence Footrace, all competitors must have start numbers fixed to their T-shirts on the chest. It shall be unacceptable, under the rigour of disqualification, to cover the start point (in its entirety or in a part) and to shorten the route.

5. The deposit shall accept personal objects of the competitors packed in bags on 11 November 2019 from 02:00 p.m. It shall be possible to collect the objects to 09:00 p.m. The bags shall be given out from the deposit against presentation of the number. Losing of the number by the competitor shall relieve the organiser from liability for collection of the bag by another person.
6. The toilets shall be located on the area of the start/finishing line.
7. The organiser shall not provide showers.

V. ENTRIES

1. Entries for participation in the Wrocław Independence Footrace shall be accepted solely electronically through completion of the entry form inserted on the website: www.wroclawmaraton.pl.
2. Making of the entry shall be considered as performance of the following two activities by the competitor, in the following order:
 - a. completion of the entry form found on the website: www.wroclawmaraton.pl,
 - b. making of the payment for the starting package via electronic payments in the Internet entry panel.
3. Cash payments shall not be accepted.
4. Entry for participation in the Wrocław Independence Footrace shall constitute confirmation of acquaintance of the competitors with these Regulations, undertaking to observe them and expression of consent to processing of the data on the health condition and to the use of the image of the participants, including consent to insertion of photos in TV, radio, Internet and printed messages as well as - in case of expression of the consent - to sending of information and questionnaires relating to the competitions organised currently and in the future by the organisers of the Wrocław Independence Footrace. The detailed scopes of the required consents are a part of the entry form for the race.
5. The data of the competitor and their start number shall be entered in the start list after posting of the payment. The organiser reserves the right to eliminate the contents having offensive or coarse nature or violating third-party rights from the start list.
6. The competitor shall have the possibility to hide their data in the start list through selection of the 'anonymous' option during completion of the entry form. The participant shall be visible as 'anonymous competitor' in the start list. In such case, only the start number of the competitor shall be visible.
7. Deadline for entries and amount of the fees:
 - a) due to limited number of participants (3,000), the starting fee shall amount to PLN 65.00;
 - b) the competitors who are 60 years of age or older (year of birth 1959 and earlier) shall pay the amount of PLN 1.00 for the starting package up to exhaustion of the limit.
8. The competitor shall be entitled to resign from participation in the Wrocław Independence Footrace by 30/09/2019. In order to resign, the competitor must send the e-mail message with the information on the resignation as well as with the account number, to which the organiser shall transfer the cash, to: biegniepodleglosci@wroclawmaraton.pl. The starting fee decreased by PLN 10.00 shall be returned within 14 days from the date of sending of the message.
9. The competitors who make the entry after 30/09/2019 shall get a standard start number (without name and surname) and the starting package in the Competition Office of the Wrocław Independence Footrace.
10. In case of non-exhaustion of the limit of competitors till 01/11/2019, the entry form shall be excluded. After closure of electronic entries, making of the entry shall be possible in the Competition Office of the Wrocław Independence Footrace during verification on 07/11/2019 - 10/11/2019.
11. The Competition Office of the Wrocław Independence Footrace is located in Wrocław at al. I.J. Paderewskiego 35, 51-612, tel. +48 511 603 063, e-mail: biegniepodleglosci@wroclawmaraton.pl. The Competition Office shall be open to Tuesday 05 November 2019 to 10:00 a.m. and after the race from 12 November 2019 from 08.00 a.m. to 03:00 p.m.
12. The condition for positive verification on 07/11/2019 - 11/11/2019 shall be:
 - a. personal attendance of the competitor with an identity document;
 - b. attendance of an authorised person who shall be obliged to submit an original of an authorisation signed by the competitor, on behalf of which the verification is performed, according to the content of the authorisation constituting Appendix 1 hereto.
13. The organiser reserves the possibility to send information relating to the Wrocław Independence Footrace to the e-mail address determined by the competitor in the entry form.

VI. CLASSIFICATIONS

1. The following classifications will be kept in the Wrocław Independence Footrace:

a. individual:

- women's,
- men's,
- Republic of Poland female citizens,
- Republic of Poland male citizens,
- in women's and men's age categories:
 - **W and M - 20:** 18 – 29 years,
 - **W and M - 30:** 30 – 39 years,
 - **W and M - 40:** 40 – 49 years,
 - **W and M - 50:** 50 – 59 years,
 - **W and M - 60:** 60 – 69 years,
 - **W and M - 70:** 70 – 79 years,
 - **W and M - 80:** 80 and older.

VII. PRIZES

1. The winners of the Wrocław Independence Footrace shall obtain:

a. cups founded by the Self-Government of the City of Wrocław in:

- men's classification: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place,
- women's classification: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place,
- female citizens of the Republic of Poland - 1st, 2nd and 3rd place,
- male citizens of the Republic of Poland - 1st, 2nd and 3rd place,

b. cash prizes:

• **in men's classification:**

- 1st place - PLN 1,500,
- 2nd place - PLN 1,000,
- 3rd place - PLN 500,

• **in women's classification:**

- 1st place - PLN 1,500,
- 2nd place - PLN 1,000,
- 3rd place - PLN 500,

• **in the classification of female citizens of the Republic of Poland:**

- 1st place - PLN 1,500,
- 2nd place - PLN 1,000,
- 3rd place - PLN 500,

• **in the classification of male citizens of the Republic of Poland:**

- 1st place - PLN 1,500,
- 2nd place - PLN 1,000,
- 3rd place - PLN 500.

The prizes shall be cumulative.

2. The winners in the age categories of women and men shall acquire the right to take part in the 8th Night Wrocław Half Marathon on condition of making of the entry and payment of the fee in the amount of **PLN 1.00** before exhaustion of the limit of the competitors.

3. The cups shall be handed in to the winners of the Wrocław Independence Footrace according to the minute programme of the event. It shall be possible to collect the cups not collected during the decoration within 30 days from the date of completion of the Wrocław Independence Footrace. After that time, they shall remain at the disposal of the organiser.

4. All female and male competitors who complete the race in 2 hours shall obtain occasional medals. The medals shall be handed in after passing of the finishing line.

5. Personal income tax shall be deducted from the cash prizes in compliance with applicable legal provisions.

6. The cash prizes acquired by the female and male competitors shall be provided solely via bank transfer to the indicated personal bank account of the competitor to 31/11/2019.

7. The female and male competitors may be subjected to anti-doping tests after completion of the race. The tests shall be conducted by the Anti-Doping Commission. Every female and male competitor selected by the Anti-Doping Commission shall be obliged to undergo the anti-doping tests, under the rigour of disqualification. In case of detection of prohibited substances in sample A, the competitor shall be entitled to request testing of sample B at their own cost. In case of a negative result of sample B, not confirming use of prohibited substances, the result of the competitor shall be maintained in the list, while in case of confirmation of the result of sample A, the Footrace Director shall disqualify the competitor. The disqualification decision shall be final and the provisions of PZLA relating to the appeal possibility shall not apply thereto.

8. The list of prohibited substances and methods is determined in Appendix 1 to the International Convention against Doping in Sport dated of 19 October 2005, with updates.

VIII. ACCOMMODATION

1. The organiser shall not provide accommodation.

IX. NUTRITION

1. After completion of the Wrocław Independence Footrace, at the finishing line the competitors shall obtain: tea and regeneration meal. The meals shall be given away on the basis of the start number.

X. FINANCING

1. The costs of organisation of the Wrocław Independence Footrace shall be covered by:
 - a. Gmina Wrocław (Commune of Wrocław),
 - b. Partners and supporting institutions
2. The costs of the entry fee, travels and other services shall be covered by the event competitors.
3. The verified competitors shall be entitled to free use of collective urban and suburban transport (tramways, buses) on 11 November 2019 against demonstration of the start number.
4. Within the fee for the starting package, the participant shall obtain:
 - a. start number + pins,
 - b. water on the route and at the finishing line,
 - c. regulations with the map of the route,
 - d. sports T-shirt,
 - e. potentially gifts.

XI. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

In compliance with art. 13 sections 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as: GDPR):


- I. For the competitor of the Wrocław Independence Footrace:
 1. The Personal Data Controller (PDC) of the personal data contained in your personal form is Młodzieżowe Centrum Sportu Wrocław (Youth Sport Centre Wrocław) with its seat at al. Ignacego Jana Paderewskiego 35, 51-612 Wrocław.
 2. The PDC has appointed the Data Protection Officer, who may be communicated in writing, with determination of the Data Protection Officer as the addressee, at the address determined in point 1 above or at the e-mail address: iod@mcs.wroc.pl or sekretariat@mcs.wroc.pl.
 3. The personal data provided by you shall be processed on the basis of the contract connected with participation in the Wrocław Independence Footrace - legal basis: art. 6 section 1 letter b of the GDPR (therefore, your data shall be processed in order to conclude the contract and to perform its terms & conditions, to perform financial settlements in the period necessary for performance of the obligations determined above). In case when you represent that you are in good health condition, the personal data shall be processed on the basis of your consent - legal basis: art. 6 section 1 letter a of the GDPR. In case when you consent to being sent information and questionnaires relating to the sport events organised by the organisers of the Wrocław Independence Footrace to your e-mail address - legal basis: art. 6 section 1 letter a of the GDPR.
 4. The PDC may provide your data in particular to the following recipients:
 - a) processors ordered to perform the data processing operations by the PDC,
 - b) other data recipients, e.g. insurers, electronic payment services, banks or entities providing Internet services.
 5. Your personal data shall be processed for the period of 5 years, i.e. for the time being necessary for performance of the obligations and exercise of the entitlements by the PDC resulting from legal provisions, connected with performance of the organisational obligations of the organiser of the event under consideration, and in case of the expressed consent to processing of the data relating to the health condition - for the period not being longer than 5 years or to the time when you withdraw your consent to its processing.
 6. You shall have the right to access your data, to request supplementation of incomplete data, to request data rectification, to request restriction of data processing, to data portability in the scope resulting from the applicable legal provisions as well as the right to withdraw the consent to its processing and to personal data erasure.

7. For the purposes of exercise of the entitlements determined in point 6 above, the requests should be submitted to the PDC via the appointed Data Protection Officer to the e-mail address: iod@mcs.wroc.pl.
8. You shall be entitled to lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority (in the meaning of the GDPR) relating to processing of your personal data, i.e. to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
9. Provision of your personal data shall be a condition for conclusion of the contract. Its provision shall be voluntary yet a failure to provide it shall result in lack of the possibility in the Wrocław Independence Footrace.
10. You may obtain the additional information connected with your entitlements and obligations as well as with the entitlements and obligations of the PDC on the Public Information Bulletin (BIP) website of the organiser: www.mcs.wroc.pl, tab: GDPR.

XII. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The organiser shall provide medical care at the start, on the route and at the finishing line of the Wrocław Independence Footrace. Medical teams shall move on the route and provide aid in compliance with the Medical Protection Plan approved by the competent Office.
2. Written protests shall be accepted at the stage of the race on 11/11/2019 to 08:00 p.m. The protests shall be examined within 1 hour from their submission.
3. The participants of the race shall be obliged to wear aesthetic clothes and sports shoes in compliance with the provisions of PZLA.
4. The competitor confirms that they take part in the Wrocław Independence Footrace on their own responsibility and bear the risk connected therewith, acknowledging the fact that participation in the Wrocław Independence Footrace is connected with physical effort and entails natural risk and threat of accidents, possibility to suffer injuries (including death) as well as material damages and losses.
5. The competitors who discontinue the race shall be able to use the car with the inscription 'Koniec Biegu' (End of Race), which shall take them to the finishing line.
6. Only vehicles with a special pass, displayed in a visible place, shall be allowed to move on the route of the Wrocław Independence Footrace.
7. The competitors shall be insured against accidents. The details of the policy (insurer, policy number, guaranteed insurance sum, general insurance terms & conditions) shall be published on the website, in section 'Regulamin' (Regulations), by 30/10/2019.
8. The organiser reserves the right to change the date of the Wrocław Independence Footrace due to occurrence or forecast of occurrence of Force Majeure, reported by the competent Office.
9. Appendix 1 shall be an integral part hereof.
